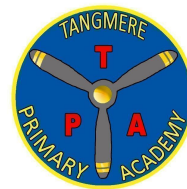

Swimming Pool

We have had lots of parents/carers getting in touch with us to investigate how they could help to make sure that we are able to open up our swimming pool again next year. The questions that they are quite rightly asking are about what we actually need to get it up and running again.

I am therefore providing a brief outline of just what we need and a very approximate idea of cost, to give everyone more of an idea of just how much is involved:

Draining and cleaning of the pool = £1600

Filter replacement = £600

New chlorinator = £500

Boiler replacement = £9000

Mandatory Pool Plant Operator training = £1000

Weekly Maintenance of the pool = £300 - £600

These costings are based upon quotes that we have been given and we would view this as the minimum, giving us a minimum costing of £13000.

This costing does not include the cost of gas or any other general maintenance of the areas around the pool such as the changing rooms.

As you can see the costs of getting the pool up and running are high, but as said we have not given up hope of being able to open it next year - but we will need help.

Thank you to all the parents/carers that have been in touch with us so far.

It would be great to get a working party behind this and make sure that such an amazing resource does not go to waste.

One of our mums approached me this week and said that she had learnt to swim in the school pool and was determined to help make sure that her children could do the same. It made me wonder how many more of you, our parents/carers, remember using the pool yourselves?
